Nomination Committee Announces Candidates

The nomination process for the board of Directors election was announced in the 4th Quarter issue of the newsletter. One (1) three-year position expires in 2023. Volunteer applications received by Friday, November 9, 2022, were reviewed by the Nominating Committee. At the November meeting of the Board of Directors, the Nominating Committee presented the following candidates:

H. Gary Cooper (incumbent)

Mr. Gary Cooper has been a member of SGFCU since 1987. He has served as a Board Member since 1999 and on various committees including the Scholarship Committee and the Nominating Committee. Mr. Cooper is a retiree of CenterPoint Energy. He is very passionate about Southern Gas FCU and has a long-standing commitment to the credit union and it's leadership.

Leslie McTigrit

Mr. Leslie McTigrit has been a member of SGFCU since 2018 and an employe of Summit Utilities (FKA CenterPoint Energy) for 14 years. When asked why he wanted to be on the board, Mr. McTigrit said, "I believe this will be a valuable learning experience and I'm looking forward to providing ideas and assisting the credit union."

Other members may be nominated by petition signed by 70 or If an election is necessary, ballots will be mailed no later than more members, accompanied by a signed certificate from the nominee agreeing to nomination and serving if elected, and accompanied by a brief statement of positions held with the credit union and other relevant experience. Each petition signor shall have a clearly written name and contact information to permit verification of each signature.

Any such nominating petition must be submitted to the Secretary of the credit union prior to February 3, 2023. The credit union Secretary will post nominations by petition, along with those of the Nominating Committee, at the credit union office no fewer than 35 days before the Annual Meeting.

Friday, February 10, 2023 to members in good standing, age 18 or older, as of January 31, 2023. All qualified ballots received by Monday, March 6, 2023 will be counted. If you do not receive a ballot and you believe you are eligible to receive a ballot, please contact Tina Plante at 501-374-2031.

If sufficient nominations are made by the Nominating Committee or by petition to provide at least as many nominees as position to be filled, nominations cannot be made from the floor.

<u>Celebrate</u> Earth Day

Earth Day is an annual event celebrated around the world on April 22. It was founded in 1970 as a day of education about environmental issues. This is the holiday's 53rd anniversary.

The Earth Day Network is changing human attitudes about and behavior toward plastics and reducing plastic pollution. Here are some ways to reduce our plastic usage:

1. Stop buying plastic bottles of water. Invest in a sturdy water bottle that you'll be able to use for years to come.

2. Say no to disposable straws. Plastic straws are one of the top 10 items found in beach clean ups. Reusable stainless steel straws are a great alternative to plastic straws. They are very durable, easy to transport, and can be reused over and over again. Other alternatives are paper straws, silicone straws, glass straws, or bamboo straws.

3. Try a bamboo toothbrush instead of plastic. If you love your plastic toothbrush and can't give it up, repurpose used ones by using them to clean around your house.

4. Using less plastic wrap is a super simple way to cut down your plastic usage (this goes for plastic zip baggies too). Instead, use glass or stainless steel containers.

5. Buy a reusable coffee cup. Because of a plastic film on the inside, very few coffee cups are recycled.
